PRO-VE 2024 is a forum for sharing and discussing current developments and experiences regarding the role of collaborative networks (CN) in managing non-linear Ecosystems and Societies.

Projects are invited from various disciplines such as Engineering, Managerial and Socio-Human sciences: industrial engineering, computer science, manufacturing, organisation science, logistics, management, and social sciences, among others, to showcase their results and approaches.

- Collaborative cognitive cyber-physical systems
- Agile design and management of collaborative networks
- Smartness and adaptability of collaborative logistics and transportation networks

- Complex hybridisation of collaboration organisations, people, machines, intelligent systems
- · Resilience, sustainability, and antifragility of networked organisations
- · Digital twins for adaptable, collaborative networks
- · Ethics, security, and trust in a changing world
- Collaborative risk and crisis management
- VUCA management in collaborative networks
- CN applications and case studies in multiple fields

In addition to the regular sessions of the Conference, a special plenary session will be scheduled to present International or National projects with relation to some of these topics, placing special emphasis on how the project is related to CN. During this session, the project presenter can discuss the objectives, development, and outputs with the conference attendees to establish a fruitful interchange of ideas. Demonstrations and Interactive sequences are welcome.
